The student admitted will be required to attend classes from September, 2024. The names of those remaining absent for seven consecutive working days from commencement of classes shall automatically be struck off the rolls without any information & seats thus rendered vacant shall be offered to the next candidates on the merit list.

INTRODUCTION

1. Homoeopathic system of Medicine, recognized by the Central and State Governments is gaining ever increasing popularity among the common people for being the most effective and yet the cheapest system of medicine. Keeping in view the efficacy utility of this system of medicine, Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh was set up in 1974 by the Homoeopathic Medical College Association, Chandigarh. The college is a premier institute in Northern India and is being managed by the strenuous efforts of the college staff and management. We are sure this institution will add new dimensions and achieve glorious heights in the days to come.
2. Initially, the college was being run in a rented building. But in 1980, the college management undertook the construction of the college and hospital on a plot of land measuring 3900.28 sq. yards allotted by the Chandigarh Administration. With the missionary zeal of the members of the association, the sapling of the past has grown in a sprawling tree. Three separate blocks, on consisting of OPD, IPD and the Administrative block and the other having various lecture halls, labs including dissection hall, has been constructed.
3. The college imparts education through a 5½ year degree course in homoeopathy (BHMS) including one-year compulsory internship, which is recognized by the National Commission of Homoeopathy (NCH), New Delhi and affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh.
4. Totally self-dependent and financially viable, the college has experienced and well qualified staff who impart practical training to the students in clinical subjects.
5. Arrangements have been made for the students to undergo clinical training in various departments in the Govt. Multispecialty Hospital, Sector 16, Chandigarh as well as in the Hospital attached to the college. For training in Postmortem, arrangements have been made in the Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh. Medical camps are arranged in the rural area regularly for imparting training in Community health to the interneers as well as to the students. The students are also taken to various field visits as per curriculum.

All parts of the internship training shall be undertaken at the Hospital / Rural Camps attached to the college. The college is providing Modular Operation theatre, Digital X-ray and Physiotherapy, ECG facilities for the benefit of patients and students. In addition, digital system analyzer for the purpose of conducting blood biochemistry tests is also available. Some more machines are likely to be added shortly. The college is going to set up a Research Centre shortly.

6. The college has a rich library with 8803 (Eight thousand eight hundred & three only) books on homoeopathy & Allied Medical subjects.
7. The college has started separate book bank facility for the needy students.
8. Internet facility and computers with Homoeopathic software are available for the benefit of students.
9. Photostat machine is available within the college premises.

10. A beautiful open enclosure has been constructed to serve as common room for the students with canteen facility.
11. It is a matter of pride that the students who have qualified from the institution have been absorbed in various institutions, national schemes run by the Government / Semi Government Departments and Non-Government organization. Some also have their own manufacturing units.

* In calculation of percentage of seats for reserved category / categories the figure has been rounded off to lower whole number if decimal point is less than 0.5 and to higher whole number if the decimal point is 0.5 or more.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Every candidate seeking admission should have attained the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, 2024.
- Candidates applying under Scheduled Caste category are required to submit the certificate regarding their category in the prescribed form (Appendix – 1) which must be signed only by officers mentioned in the form. Signatures of any other officer will not be accepted & such applications will be rejected.
- Reservation for (Person with Disability) has been provided for persons** i.e. 01 seat (1st preference to the candidates suffering from Locomotor disabilities of Lower Limbs between 50% - 70% disability is available). (Appendix II).
- Applicant will be made under the criteria laid down by the Chandigarh Administration / Panjab University, Chandigarh.
- Blind (including colour blind) deaf and or dumb candidates shall not be allowed admission in the course.
- The candidates who have passed 10+2 examination in April 2024 from a recognized Board "Body" Council or any other examination recognized as equivalent to 10+2 examination by the Panjab University with **Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English** and has qualified the entrance test shall be eligible to join the first year class of the course. **The candidates who were placed under compartment in 10+2 examination in 2024 are not eligible.**

CLARIFICATIONS

If the requisite number of students belonging to Scheduled Caste Category / PWD are not available, seats thus remaining vacant will be open to students of the General Category.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION TO BHMS

GENERAL RULES

- a) Admitted student will fill up admission form of this college and complete other formalities as per colleges regulations.
- b) **Fee is to be paid on the spot on the day of the admission.**
- c) **Candidates who fail to appear for counseling on the specified date & time will not be considered.**
- d) Any seat(s) left vacant against the reserved categories shall be de-reserved and added to the general category seats at the end of the admission process for the reserved categories.

The students belonging to a reserved category admitted on the basis of his/her merit in the general category shall not be counted for towards the seats reserved for the categories concerned.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- I. Admission will be made strictly on merit for candidates of all categories. A separate merit list for each category will be prepared based upon the marks obtained in NEET 2024. The result of the NEET 2024 ipso facto, does not entitle a candidate to get admission
- II. **Candidates who have passed the 10+2 examination in supplementary 2024 are not eligible.**
- III. In the event of a tie in the marks obtained in NEET 2024 a candidate getting higher percentage of total marks in the qualifying (10+2) examination in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry & Biology shall rank higher and if the marks in 10+2 examination in the said subjects are also the same, then the candidate older in age shall rank higher.
- IV. In case the information furnished or certificates/documents submitted are found to be fake or the candidate is found to have withheld or concealed information in the application form, notwithstanding legal action under the law of the land his/her admission shall stand cancelled and the fee deposited shall be forfeited.
- V. All legal disputes relating to admission of students will be subjects to courts having jurisdiction in Chandigarh.
- VI. The candidature of those eligible candidates, **who do not deposit the prescribed fee in full immediately after selection, shall stand automatically cancelled,** and vacancies so caused will be offered to the candidates next in order of merit. No correspondence or appeals in this connection will be entertained. **The candidate should produce original**

- documents at the time of admission for verification.** The attested copies of the certificates or similar other documents will not be entertained for granting admission to a candidate to the BHMS Course.
- VII. Candidates passing their (10+2) or equivalent examination from Boards / Councils other than Schools Education Board of Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Delhi state will have to **submit migration certificate** from the respective Council / Board within a month from the date of enrolment.
- VIII. **All admission to BHMS Course shall be provisional and subject to approval by the Panjab University.**
- IX. Students admitted to the course will be required to attend classes immediately. If a **student remains absent from classes for seven consecutive working days, from the date of commencement of classes his / her name will automatically be struck off the rolls without any intimation** and the seat thus rendered vacant will be offered to the next candidate of the waiting list of respective category.
- X. **No alterations will be allowed in the application form after its submission**
- XI. Re-admission will be as per rules of Panjab University / NCH.
- XII. The last date of receipt of Original Certificates is **30th October 2024**, penalty will be charged as per Panjab University rules.
- XIII. **The original certificates of the selected students will be retained by the college and shall returned only if the seat is surrendered by the candidate, as per instructions received from Director General health Services. Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi vide letter No. F.No. U12023/33/2209-MEC (Pt. II) dated 03.02.2010**
- XIV. **As per Panjab University Order¹ Endst No. Misc/A-6/59381-59581, Dated 10.04.2015, a column for transgenders (TG) under general category has been incorporated in the application form.**

OVERRIDING CONDITIONS

- I. Admissions are made according to the rules and regulations as mentioned in this prospectus. However, in all matters which either need interpretation or for which no provision exists in the prospectus the **decision of the Admission Committee shall be final.** No correspondence will be entertained regarding rejection or disqualification of any candidate.

MISCELLANEOUS

Each candidate shall fill up the application form in his / her own handwriting.

Candidates should clearly note that migration will not be permitted as a matter of right.

Classes for failed / re-appear students will start immediately after the declaration of their results. Attendance in these classes is compulsory.

Payment of fees must be made by cash / demand draft drawn in favor of Principal, Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh. **Personal bank cheque will not be accepted.** If any candidate withdraws, the refund of

the fees will be as per directions of Chandigarh Administration / Panjab University, Chandigarh.

The courses of study & examinations will be as per regulation of the Panjab University, Chandigarh.

The rules & regulations, including fee to be charged, are subject to revision & amendment from time to time & the revised rules & regulations will be applicable irrespective of those given in this prospectus.

COUNSELING AND GUIDANCE

Democratic atmosphere is maintained among the students and teachers. Student's personal problems are looked into and necessary counseling and guidance is given by the teachers. The students are free to approach any faculty member for the purpose.

IMPORTANT NOTE

In case, any candidate found to have supplied false information, certificate etc. or is found to have concealed or withheld some information in her / his applications from, she / he shall be debarred from admission. Any other action that may be considered appropriate by the Director of the institute may also be taken against her / him which includes criminal prosecution.

Each application must be accompanied by the attested Photostat copies of the following documents, failing which the application will be treated incomplete and rejected.

1. Certificate of having passed Matriculation & 10+2 examinations.
2. Matriculation or equivalent certificate showing date of birth.
3. Character certificate from the Head of the institution last attended.
4. A declaration to the effect that he / she is not employed anywhere.
5. Two references from respectable & responsible persons in the area certifying good moral character and non-affiliation to any Political party.
6. Three passport size recent photographs.
7. Family income certificate from concerned office in case of Govt. Employees and from Oath Commissioner in case of businessman.
8. Affidavit attested by Magistrate 1st class / Notary Public, explaining gap in studies if any.

REFUND OF PAYMENT:-

- I. The candidates who are admitted to the course and want to surrender the seat prior to the last date of admission schedule approved by the Panjab University may be refunded the entire amount of fees and funds collected at the time of counseling after retaining Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) as administrative / processing charges provided the vacant seat is filled up.
- II. The candidate will have to pay the exact amount as per P.U. fee structure prevailing at the time of admission. The amount mentioned above are approximate. Therefore, the candidates are advised to bring sufficient money

to cover the increase if any. The amounts over and above the fee structure if any will be accepted in cash.

- III. No charges are refundable if the seat remains unfilled.
- IV. In case a candidate vacates the seat after the last date fixed by the Panjab University as per its schedule, the candidate will have to fill indemnity bond in favor of college Principal of Rs. 1,28,750/- for surrendering the seat to avoid financial loss to the management of the college. A specimen copy of indemnity bond is appended as Appendix III.
- V. The fee structure is subject to revision by the competent authority irrespective of details given in the prospectus.

NOTE:

No original certificates should be enclosed by the candidates with the application. However, the same must be produced at the time of interview, failing which their candidature will not be considered and any claim for a seat in Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Sector 26, Chandigarh shall be rejected.

The rules are subject to change as per directions by the NCH / Panjab University / Chandigarh Administration from time to time without any prior intimation.

Proof for claim of reserved category, will have to be provided if claimed as per Reservation Rules.

NOTE:-

The above fee structure will be applicable to the newly admitted students to the First year BHMS course session 2024-25 or to be admitted thereafter and not to those already on the rolls of the college.

An amount of Rs. 18,150/- will be charged in the BHMS III Prof. for clinical training in the Govt. Multispecialty Hospital, Sector 16, Chandigarh, vide notification No. MS-II 2005/311, dated 10.01.2005 of Chandigarh Administration. The students who will not attending clinical classes are fined as per the college rules.

COLLEGE RULES FOR THE STUDENTS

All the students shall comply with the college rules and regulations.

1. Regular and punctual attendance in all class activities like lectures, demonstrations, practicals, clinical, tutorials and tests as well as in all college activities like guest lectures, seminars, sports and cultural & extra curricular activities is compulsory. Each student must maintain the minimum percentage of 75% attendance required in all the classes and college activities. Students, whose conduct and academic standards are

- found unsatisfactory, shall not be allowed to take the University examinations.
2. A deficiency in the required number of lectures, clinical and practicals may be condoned by the Principal, under mitigating circumstance, to the extent of 5%.
 3. Leave of absence from the classes must be taken from the class incharge. In case of illness, a medical certificate by a qualified doctor must be sent immediately.
 4. Students are not allowed to put notices within the institutions without prior permission from the office of the Principal and are also forbidden to communicate with any outside authority directly. All such communications must be submitted through the Principal, who will forward these if considered desirable. Any student infringing this rule may be suspended.
 5. The college does not hold itself responsible for debts incurred by the students in any way.
 6. Students must pay for all damages caused by them to books and other college property. Breakages of the apparatus(es), in excess of Rs. 50 will be paid for by the students.
 7. The following are STRICTLY FORBIDDEN within any part of the institution:
 - i. Possession or use of alcoholic beverages.
 - ii. Possession or use of addictive or hallucinogenic drugs.
 - iii. Smoking
 - iv. Gambling
 - v. Possession or use of firearms of any lethal weapons.
 - vi. Loitering around, especially under the influence of alcohol
 - vii. To keep the campus clean & environment friendly avoid polythene bags & littering
 8. Students are not permitted to use the college telephones.
 9.
 - a) **RAGGING of students has been banned by the Supreme Court of India in SLP (C) 24298/2004 passes an order on 10th December 2007 and is strictly FORBIDDEN, it is punishable by a fine. Any student involved in ragging is liable to the punishment of rustication or expulsion from the college. Ragging is defined as will full degrading or humiliating a fellow student. It also included will fully degrading or humiliating a fellow student, whereby he / she suffers distress of mind or spirit.**
 - b) In case of ragging, the following recommendation were made by the committee constituted pursuant to court order.

- i. The punishment to be meted out has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.
- ii. **Every single incident of ragging where the victim or his parent / guardian or the head of institution is not satisfied with the institutional arrangement for action, a First information Report must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities. Any failure on the part of the Institutional authority of negligence or deliberate delay in lodging the FIR with the local police shall be constructed to be act of culpable negligence on the part of the Institutional authority. If any victim or his parent / guardian of ragging intends to file FIR directly with the police that will not absolve the institutional authority from the requirement of filing the FIR.**
- iii. In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in gagging in the past or if it is noticed later that he has indulged in ragging, admission will be refused or he / she shall be expelled from the educational institution.
- iv. All the enrolled students are required to fill their undertaking / affidavit on any of the following two websites: www.amanmovemnet.org, www.antiragging.in
- v. College comprises of Anti Ragging Committee to deal with matters.

10. Students must arrange for washable white coats, which are to be worn at all times in the college laboratories and on hospital duty and also provide their own dissection instruments.

11. College fees must be paid in full by the due dates. Any student whose fees, together with the fine imposed, found unpaid will be suspended from attending lectures, practicals, clinical etc., until the fees, dues have been paid.

12. All irregularities, neglect of duties, breach of rules and indiscipline are to be brought to the notice of the Principal, who in consultation with senior staff members shall deal with any serious offence, for which an adverse entry in personal files / student record register will be made. The penalty may either be a written or verbal warning fine suspension and / or removal as an office bearer of any organization and / or removal expulsion from the college. The Principal is competent to remit the fine imposed by him.

13. The decision of the college in all disputes would be final and binding on the students.

14. Students must inform the office, if they change their address with Telephone Numbers. If the fail to do so, they will be responsible for any lack of communication from the office.

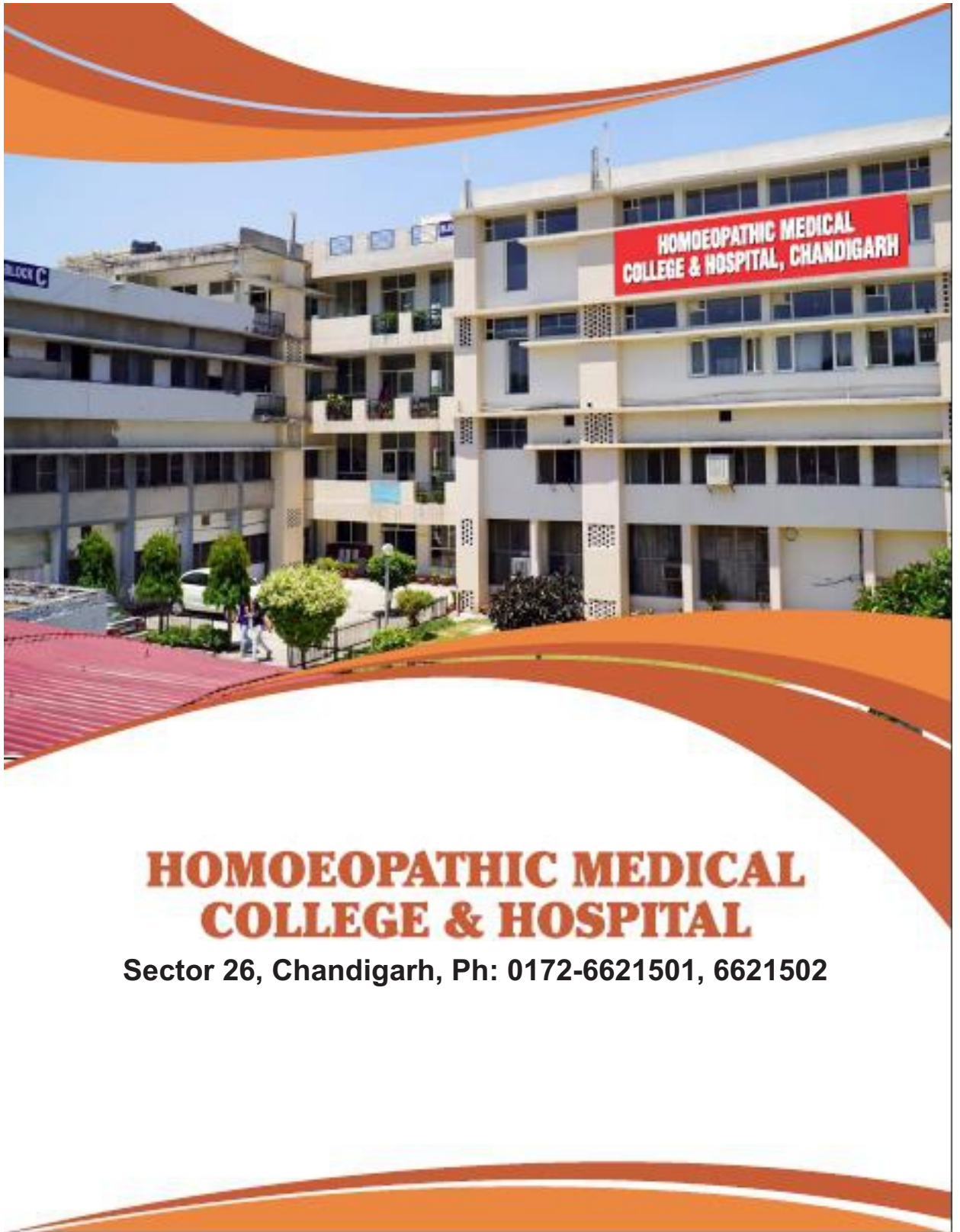
